Mortality <6 hrs	<2%	10%	Colostrum: 50ml/kg BW within 2 hours
Mortality 6-36 hrs	<2%	5%	Colostrum 200ml/BW within 24 hours
Perinatal Mortality	2%	<10%	Average 10-25%, 5% is achievable
Watery mouth	<1%	5%	Lack of colostrum, starvation
Navel ill	<1%	5%	Navel dipping (15m) (repeated +2-4hrs), hygiene
Joint ill	<2%	5%	Navel dipping, hygiene
Scour	<1%	5%	It is important to find out more about the causes of diarrhoea and get acceptable ranges for each cause. This will also help target how to control scour better
Bacterial			Eg. E. coli, Salmonella
Parasitic			Coccidiosis, Nematodirus
Nutritional			
Pneumonia	<2%	20%	Most pneumonia cases are caused by Pasteurellosis and cause sudden death Make sure lambs (or their mothers) are vaccinated
Lameness	<2%	10%	Scald, joint ill
Birth weights			Can be recorded within the first 24 hours of life, less than quoted = ewes undernourished and at risk of TLD
Single	5.5kg

Triplets	>4.0kg
